



ALBY BARRIE AWARD

(Club person of the year)

The Alby Barrie Award for club person of the year is the highest individual honour one can be bestowed at the South Adelaide basketball Club, behind only that of life membership.

Purpose

The purpose of this award is to recognise and acknowledge outstanding individuals who have shown dedication, commitment and made a significant contribution to the South Adelaide Basketball Club.

Nomination Criteria - The recipient must:

- Be a financial member of South Adelaide Basketball Club.
- Have demonstrated outstanding service, commitment and gone above and beyond what is expected of a club member.
- Be a person who has assisted in some measure or aspect, in ensuring the success or betterment of the club in the current season.

Nomination Process:

- Nominations can be made by any financial member of the South Adelaide Basketball Club.
- Nominations are to be made in writing and submitted to the club secretary by no later than 1st August each year.
- All nominations will be considered by the South Adelaide Basketball Club Committee.

Presentation:

The recipient of the Alby Barrie Award will be announced at the annual South Adelaide Basketball Club presentations function. They will receive an award plaque & have their name installed on the honour board at the stadium.

Note: The Alby Barrie Award may not necessarily be granted each year. This may be because there are no nominations, or the committee may deem that the nomination/s received do not meet the criteria.
